

**LIST OF THE SERVICES PROVIDED BY
THE COUNCIL FOR ELECTRONIC MEDIA (CEM)**

1. Grant, amend, transfer or cancel individual licenses for the provision of radio services intended for distribution through existing and/or new electronic communication networks for terrestrial analogue broadcasting;
2. Request (including on behalf of an interested entity) the Communications Regulation Commission to provide information concerning the technical parameters required for the terrestrial analogue broadcasting of radio and TV programmes within a specified place/region and/or throughout Bulgaria, such as available radio frequencies, emission power limits, available emission sites and other relevant technical information;
3. Grant, amend, transfer or cancel individual licenses for the provision of radio or audiovisual services eligible for distribution by an entity which has received a permit for the use of a scarce resource — namely specified bandwidth of the radio spectrum — for the purposes of carrying out electronic communications through terrestrial digital broadcasting networks of national and/or regional coverage;
4. Maintain a register of radio and TV programmes, accept, modify or delete registrations and issue certificates of registration;
5. Enter the providers of linear media services and the services provided by them in Sections I and III of the Public Register maintained in accordance with Article 125k of the Radio and Television Act (RTVA); Change or delete certain entries in existing registrations as appropriate;
6. Enter the entities which intend to provide on-demand media services in Section IV of the Public Register maintained in accordance with Article 125k of the RTVA; Change or delete certain entries in existing registrations as appropriate;
7. Enter the international programmes which can be distributed within the territory of Bulgaria in Section V of the Public Register maintained in accordance with Article 125k of the RTVA; Change or delete certain entries in existing registrations as appropriate;
8. Enter the distributors of Bulgarian and international programmes as well as details of the distributed programmes in Section V of the Public Register maintained in accordance with Article 125k; Change or delete certain entries in existing registrations as appropriate;
9. Provide duplicates of documents issued by the CEM;
10. Provide certified copies of documents issued by the CEM;
11. Deal with applications for access to public information pursuant to the Access to Public Information Act (APIA);
12. Provide other services which the law mandates to the CEM.
